This course covers the rules and regulations to obtain a license to carry a concealed firearm in the State of Texas, as well as the safety, maintenance and storage of a firearm. For ages 21 and over or 18 years old if actively serving in the military.

The classroom training will cover all state required topics, Basic Firearms Safety, Safe Handling and Storage, Non-Violent Dispute Resolution, Use of Force Laws, Civil Liability, Texas Concealed Handgun Laws, Shooting Grip / Stance, Firearm Selection, and Concealed Carry Methods. This class does not teach you how to use a handgun.

### **The live fire qualification will take place in Denton/Collin County**

The range portion consists of fifty shots fired from distances of 3, 7, and 15 yards. It is preferred that students be somewhat familiar with their pistol and shooting experience is required. Accommodations can be made for students needing additional instruction, assistance, or encouragement. Every effort will be made to provide a safe, comfortable, and enjoyable shooting experience for all. The minimum score to qualify is 175 and the max is 250.

### **Each Student will need the following items on the Range:**

- Footwear that covers the entire foot.
- Low cut shirts are discouraged due to flying brass.
- Handgun: Revolver (minimum .32 caliber) or Semi-Auto (minimum .380) It no longer matters what type of handgun is used to qualifying. You will be licensed to carry semi-auto or revolver.
- Handguns should be in safe working order and be transported unloaded in some type of case or bag. Provide ear and eye protection
- Ammunition: Minimum 50 rounds required for testing (additional may be required for re-test)
- No Gun? No Problem! Rental handguns are available for \$10

### **There are three fees involved with obtaining a Texas CHL**

#### **1. CLASS FEE (paid to Town of Little Elm) New License \$60**

\$10 Discount for Veterans/Active Duty (must register in person for status verification)

This fee covers the training class, forms, the cost of the range, targets (license photos are no longer required). Class registration fees are non-refundable, but may be transferred to another session

#### **2. State Licensing Fee (paid to the State)**

\$140 for a first time four year license. \$70 for those age 60+ and \$25 for military veterans. Current military (or those released from duty in the last year) are free. This fee is paid directly to the State and must be submitted within six months of completing the class. Students do not have to apply with the State prior to attending the class but they can if they so choose. #### **3. Fingerprinting Fee (paid to L-1)**

The state has contracted with L-1 Identity Solutions to collect all electronic fingerprints. The cost is \$10 and there are multiple locations in our area. Go to <http://www.l1enrollment.com/state/?st=tx> for electronic fingerprinting info.
